Course Outline:

- Roping up for glacier travel
- Traveling on a glacier
- Snow anchors
- Mechanical advantage systems
- Crevasse rescue systems

Prerequisite Skills:

- Basic climbing knots
- Tying into ropes
- Belaying
- Two-point anchor
- Rappel with a backup safety

Required personal gear:

Climbing helmet, harness, belay/rappel device, 6 carabiners (4 locking), 4m webbing sling, 2X5m 7mm cord, rope gloves, eye protection recommended
